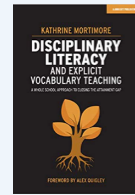
## Research and Development Group Update:

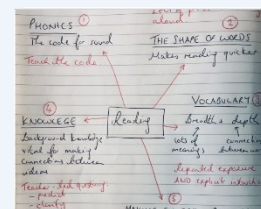
