sitting GCSE papers in all subjects in examination conditions. They should be preparing for this well in advance using revision tools to consolidate Year 12

knowledge.

## In School Support

- Time during PD sessions dedicated to revision so students can have an extra 30 minutes of Independent Study every morning.
- Sixth Form is open to all year 13 students from 8am till 4.30pm
- Support with UCAS and apprenticeship applications
- 1:1 mentoring program with tutors
- Revision resources provided for year 13 students within the sixth form area
- Extra-curricular revision sessions will operate in most subjects. We will publish in writing a timetable of all subjects' revision on offer as well as highlighting on our website.
- We operate a staff mentoring strategy for individuals who are significantly underachieving across a number of subjects. As it is a 1:1 strategy, there is a limited capacity for this. Focus students will be spoken to by their tutor. This will begin in the next two weeks.
- We will use Personal Development Time to promote effective revision techniques and allow opportunities for personal revision time.
