Dear Parent/Guardian

As we approach the end of a long term, I wanted to update you on some events of note as well as highlight key dates for the Spring Term.

#### Year 11 and 13 Mocks

The Year 11 and 13 students have just completed their Mock examinations and now begin their run into the final Summer series. Their conduct during the Mock period has been exceptional. The Mocks culminate in a results day (10 January) where students will receive their outcomes in an envelope (much as they will in August). We can already see that those students who diligently prepared for their exams have reaped the benefit and those who have not engaged in a productive revision programme will likely be disappointed. As such, we focus heavily on revision techniques with students on return and also host parental events to raise awareness of effective revision so families can support their children.

#### **Year 7 Careers Event**

Our Year 7's enjoyed a "day with a difference", coming away from a normal timetable to get an insight into different careers.

We were fortunate to host visitors from a range of different vocations who talked to children about their career path and answered questions. The purpose was to demystify certain jobs, remove stereotypes and misconceptions around particular career paths and convey key messages about employment and life beyond education. The children were brilliant and engaged really well with our visiting engineer, surgical nurse, solicitor, barrister, butcher, pharmacist etc

# **Sixth Form Interviews**

Year 11 students have been busy making applications for Sixth Form, and it has been a pleasure to be involved in the interview panel for a large number of these. It has been encouraging to see their focus and maturity in making important decisions about next steps.

### Perseverance

Our half-term character value that we have been rewarding in classes has been perseverance. This has been promoted through assemblies but also encouraged in classes and rewarded through our token system. It was flagged in our November Teaching and Learning Review that students can be quick to lose motivation when presented with challenge in classrooms. We have emphasised to students that without persistently working towards tasks that are difficult, without necessarily seeing immediate success, personal growth is very difficult.

It has been an absolute pleasure to attend the end of term celebration assemblies. Alongside a performance from our school production 'Little Shop of Horrors', students have received recognition through Subject Stars, House Point Awards, Homework recognition as well as 100% attendance achievement.
