Uniform Update - (during hot weather)

I would like to update you all regarding uniform requirements.

Firstly, it is vital that the school community have a collective approach to wearing uniform. It centralises our identity as members of Hedingham School. We also recognise that, on occasions, adaptation is required but these decisions on exemptions must remain with the school.

We continually monitor the weather conditions and make a judgement about working conditions in classrooms. The temperature in the UK is extremely volatile so this needs careful consideration.

Temperatures towards the end of the week are predicted to reduce to normal for this time of year (20-22°C). Therefore, we have made the decision to maintain normal school uniform, with the exception of blazers. This will be reviewed at the end of the week. If over the next few weeks, the temperature becomes excessively warm, then we will initiate further adjustments.

As always, if there is a valid reason why your son/daughter is unable to wear any items of school uniform then please contact their Year Leader in the first instance.

I would like to thank you in advance for your support in this matter. It is very important that we work together to ensure that our students receive a consistent message related to school expectations.
