GCSE Poetry Live - Thursday 6 February 2025

I would like to invite your child to take part in the GCSE Poetry Live lectures at the New Theatre, Peterborough. The visit will consist of spending the day hearing about the very important work created by leading UK poets that appear in our GCSE Power and Conflict Poetry Anthology. The day will include sessions by the following individuals:

- Simon Armitage (Remains)
- Carol Ann Duffy (War Photographer)
- John Agard (Checking Out Me History)
- Imtiaz Dharker (Tissue)

There will also be a further session covering top tips for examination success by an experienced English examiner relevant to the GCSE examinations.

There will a series of sessions in which the poets will respond to student questions and discuss how poems connect to and influence other poems. In the examiner sessions, the highly experienced Chief Examiners will deal with two skills vital for success in the GCSE English Literature examinations. The first session will look at how students might deal with unseen poems in the exam; both how to think about them and how to write for the best possible results. The second session will look at comparing poems, whether they are studied poems or unseen, and how to write most effectively in either situation.

We will travel by coach and students will need to be at school at 8.00am. We expect to return by 5.30pm. Students will need a packed lunch. We will remain seated in the theatre all day and students are not able leave the building to purchase lunch.

The cost of the visit is £57.00 per student and includes all travel.
