## Year 11- December Update

Firstly, I would like to say a huge well done to all Year 11, they have had an intense couple of weeks with their mocks but have risen to the challenge. It was one of the most successful mock sessions we have delivered and this has been largely down to the attitude of the students.

As we approach Christmas we conclude the first milestone of the Year 11 credit system, the points they have earned thus far will determine if they're allowed to participate in dress up day. Students have embraced the credit system and by the final week of this term they have an average of 54 credits per student.

The Christmas break will allow them time to relax and reflect before we continue the build towards their GCSE's. There will be a mock results day in the first week back where students will receive their results in a similar way to the summer. Those grades will reflect the mocks they sat and in some subjects this will not have been the full course, therefore more information about how the grades for mocks have been calculated will follow when their reports are sent home.

There will be another Year 11 Parents' Information Evening towards the end of January with the focus on effective revision and path ahead to Easter. The date for this will be confirmed in the new year.
