Year 13 Information

With the first term of Year 13 behind us, I wanted to update you of our plan between now and the Easter holidays. It has been a busy first term and I am sure that as proximity to Summer examinations draws closer, you are anxious to gain a clarity about what is ahead.

Key Dates

Thursday 4 – Friday 5 January 2024	All students will complete exam wraps and progress reflections to self-evaluate how they feel their mocks went.
Friday 12 January 2024	Deadline for all Year 13 teaching staff to enter new predictions that will be used to compile reports. This information will be sent home to parents.
8 – 19 January 2024	Mentor Meetings. All students will have mentor meetings with their tutors during this period. During these meetings they will use exam wraps and reflections as the starting point for these meetings.
Thursday 25 January 2024	Year 13 Parental Information Evening
Wednesday 31 January 2024	Final UCAS deadline
Monday 4 – Friday 15 March 2024	Year 13 assessment window. During this period teachers will set assessments for students to take to monitor their progress in subjects. The content of the exams will be down to individual subjects to decide.

- 1:1 mentoring program with tutors
